

Tosca Ticket Drawing: OFFICIAL RULES

There will be no exceptions to these rules for any circumstances.

The Annapolis Opera is offering a series of three free drawings to purchase up to one pair (two) tickets at \$25.00 per ticket to the Friday March 12, 2010 performance of Puccini's *Tosca*.

Limits: one (1) entry per performance per person per household per week. Entrants with multiple weekly entries per person or household will be disqualified. Winners can purchase a maximum of two tickets. Open only to United States citizens and legal residents at least 18 years of age who submit an entry from within the United States. Directors, officers, employees and agents of The Annapolis Opera and their families and household members are not eligible. Void where prohibited by law.

Entries can be submitted only via the Annapolis Opera website (www.AnnapolisOpera.org) beginning 10:00 AM ET on the three Mondays before the performance. No entries will be accepted via any other means whatsoever for any reason. Entries generated by script, macro, bot or other automated means are prohibited and will be disqualified. Entries must be received no later than 11:59 PM ET on that Monday, without exception, including any malfunction of the Annapolis Opera website or any internet facilities causing late receipt of entries. The Annapolis Opera's determination of eligibility is final.

Winners will be selected at random and announced on Tuesday at 1:00 PM ET. Winners will be notified by email. By entering the Drawing, you consent to your name being listed on the Annapolis Opera mailing list and other Annapolis Opera materials.

Winners must purchase their tickets by 5:00 pm ET on Thursday of the week of the drawing by either calling 410-280--5640 or by visiting the Maryland Hall Box Office. These are the only means by which tickets may be obtained at the subsidized price. Confirmation e-mail and proof of identification must be presented at the Box Office window to receive tickets. Specific pairs of seat locations are random within Section A and are not negotiable. Tickets not purchased by 5:00 PM ET on Thursday will go back into the box office for sale at regular price. Winners are encouraged to pick up their tickets as soon as they are purchased. Your tickets will be held at the Maryland Hall Box Office. Box Office hours are: Monday - Friday 12pm-5pm. If you must pick up the tickets on the day of the performance, please give yourself at least 30 minutes to allow for any lines that may have formed. All ticket sales are final.

The Annapolis Opera makes no warranties or guarantees, express or implied, with regard to the Drawing. Each Winner may, at the discretion of The Annapolis Opera, be required to sign an Affidavit of Eligibility and/or Release, and failure to do so within the time specified will result in forfeiture of any tickets. All entries become the property of The Annapolis Opera.

Drawing, including without limitation, the selection of the Winners.
